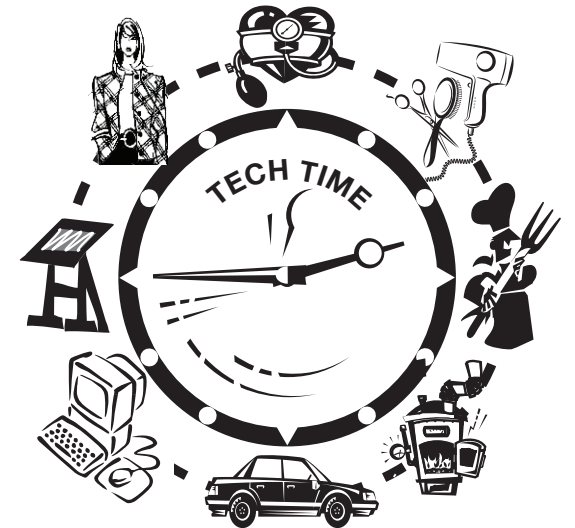

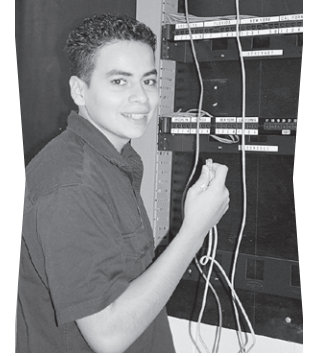

Automotive Technology

Cisco Networking Academy

Start with Cisco Level 1 or 2 or if you have already completed these at a local Cisco Academy you can complete the requirements for semesters 3 or 4.

Computer Networking

Begin with an understanding of networking technology. Use the latest technological equipment to learn about binary system, Windows operating environment and other computer concepts. This will lead to enrollment in Cisco Networking Academy.

Culinary Arts

Develop cooking skills through actual experience in Tech's professional kitchen. Make and taste delicious dishes as you learn basic and advanced food preparation techniques along with safety, nutrition and NYS sanitation requirements for restaurants, cafeterias and hospitals.

Drafting/ CAD

Use a combination of traditional drawing tools, drafting instruments and sophisticated computer programs to design and prepare architectural renderings, building models and site plans.

Fashion Merchandising/ Design

Use your flair for fashion as you learn about the business of fashion. See your own designs come to life as you create your own clothing. Develop an understanding of patterns, styles, fabrics, fashion merchandising, customer relations and retail management.

Graphic Design/Advertising

Apply your artistic talents to develop your skills in illustrating, lettering, color selection, graphic design, animation and advertising using digital imaging tools and design board techniques. Excellent for students who are interested in artistic/visual design or want a creative experience working with computer design software and graphic design tools.

Health Careers

If you like helping people and you want a career with many opportunities, get ready to enter the health care field! Obtain the knowledge and skills necessary to care for the sick in health care institutions as well as in private homes. Find out about a variety of health careers!

Heating/ Ventilation/Air Conditioning (HVAC)
