Wilson Technological Center is the career and technical education program of Western Suffolk BOCES.

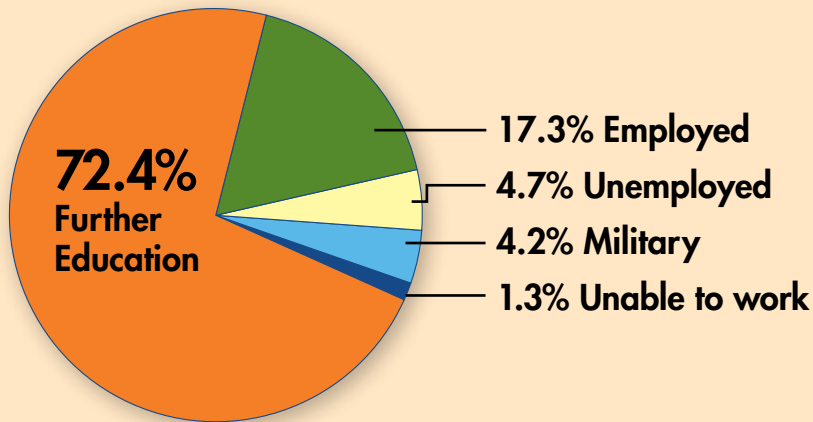

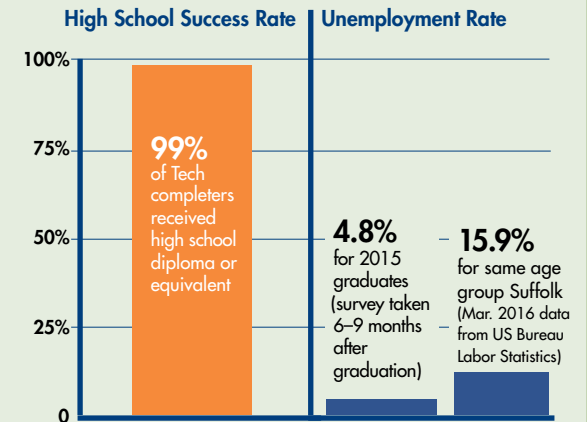
