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#### **COMING FALL 2023: RECOVERY COACH**

NOTE: These classes can be taken by CASAC (Credentialed Alcohol and Substance Abuse Counselor) and CPS (Credentialed Prevention Specialist), & for re-credentialing and continuing education credits. Prepare to work in the addiction and mental health field as a Recovery Coach who helps people along the path of recovery before, during, after or instead of treatment. Recovery Coaches do not provide clinical help or dispense medication. They work with the recoveree, as a solo coach or part of a team.
